

College Credit Plus (CCP)

Interested in taking college classes through Goal next school year (2024-2025)? College Credit Plus (CCP) allows students to start earning college credit and receive credit for high school classes. Tuition is paid for by Goal as long as the classes are passed. Students are eligible in grades 7-12. Goal recommends strong academic performance and at least a 3.0 grade point average (GPA). Colleges may also require a placement test.

In order to participate, you must meet with a school counselor from Goal. A letter of intent form will be filled out and turned in by **March 29, 2024.** Even if a student has participated in the past, a new form must be filled out and signed.

Please contact the school counselor closest to your lab to set up an <u>appointment</u>. This is <u>required</u> to participate in College Credit Plus next year.
